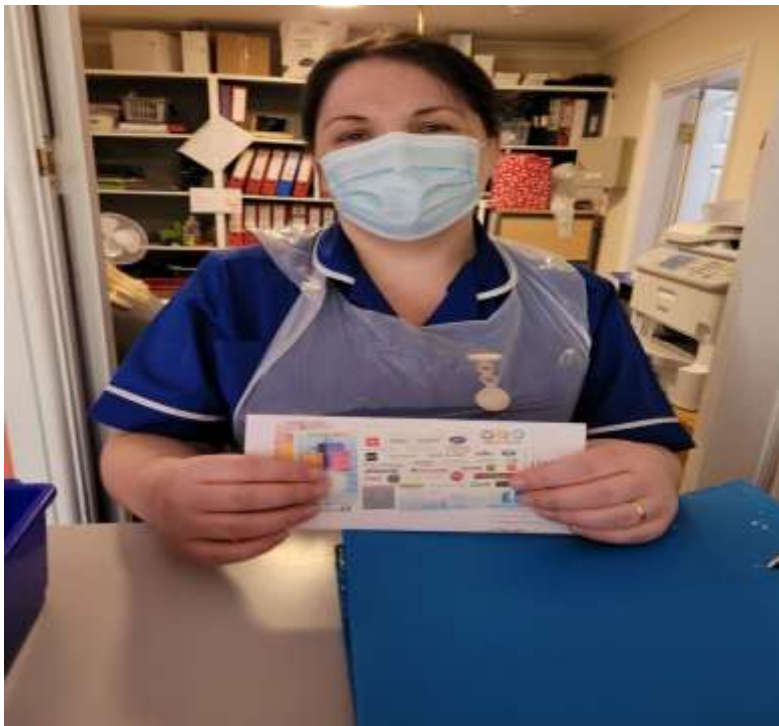
KARL'S A SINGER
