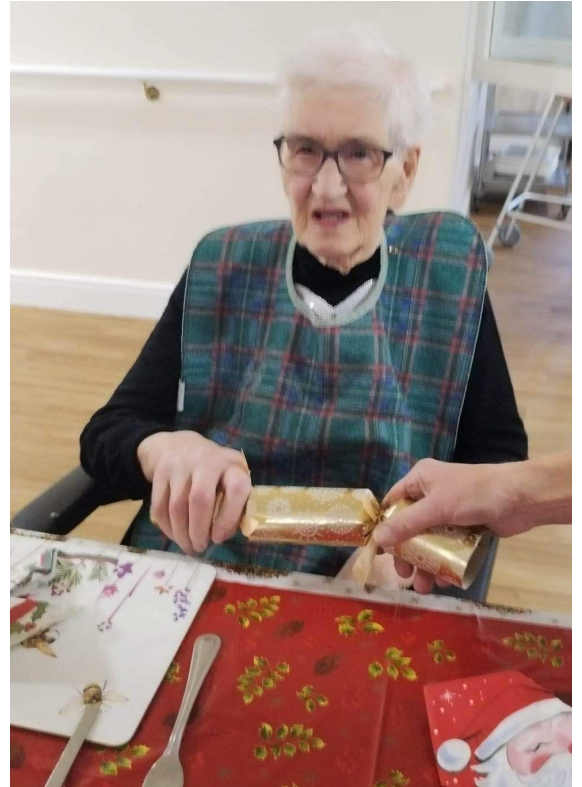

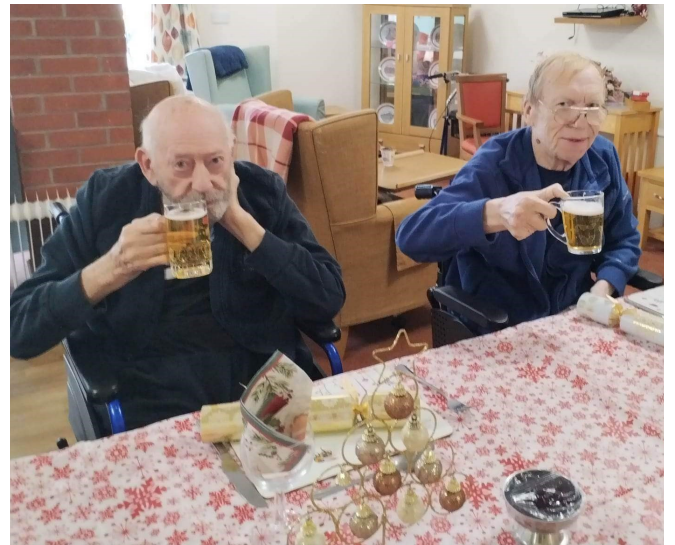
We have had lots of laughs along the way this December, taking photos and making the best of things when we were closed for that short period of time.
